Announcement is made of the following award:


Award: Army Superior Unit Award
Period of service: 15 February 2008 to 15 February 2009
Authority: AR 600-8-22, paragraph 7-16
Reason: For outstanding meritorious service. During the period 15 February 2008 to 15 February 2009, U.S. Army Task Force Sinai and its subordinate unit displayed outstanding meritorious service in support of the Multi-National Force and Observers' mission of upholding the peace treaty between Egypt and Israel. The unit provided the command and control element of the multi-national force which consisted of units from eleven different nations. In doing so, the unit oversaw peacekeeping operations and directed observation posts throughout the Sinai Peninsula, including the turbulent Gaza Strip. U.S. Army Task Force, Sinai's outstanding performance of duty is in keeping with the finest traditions of military service and reflects distinct credit upon the unit and the United States Army.

The streamers will then be manufactured and sent to the U.S. Army Human Resources Command
