Award: Army Superior Unit Award

Period of service: 1 January 2011 to 31 December 2011

Authority: AR 600-8-22, paragraph 7-16

Reason: For outstanding meritorious service. During the period 1 January 2011 to 31 December 2011, Headquarters, United States Army Cadet Command and the cited units excelled in a year dominated by a Base Realignment and Closure directed move of the headquarters to Fort Knox, Kentucky. The Cadet Command and cited units exceeded all goals and standards during transformation from their original headquarters. With over 34,000 Senior Reserve Officer Training Corp and 302,000 Junior Reserve Officer Training Corp Cadets enrolled in the program, Cadet Command met the challenges of relocation and reorganization without compromising the critical training of these future leaders. The resulting successful actions of the command bring great credit upon the Soldiers, the Department of the Army, Civilians of the United States Army Cadet Command and the United States Army.
