
Reason: For extraordinary heroism in action against an armed enemy. During the period 27 November 2007 to 10 January 2009, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Battalion, 4th Infantry Regiment and its subordinate units displayed extraordinary heroism in action against an armed enemy during combat operations in the Al-Doura section of Baghdad, Iraq. The unit's resolve and determination led to the defeat of the criminal insurgency in Al-Doura, one of Al Qaida's last strongholds in Baghdad. Discipline and selfless service characterized the unit's tour of duty as they constantly placed themselves in harm's way to protect and provide security for Iraqi citizens. The unit's tenacity decimated the insurgency and restored Al-Doura to its rightful place as the cultural center of Iraq. Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Battalion, 4th Infantry Regiment's outstanding performance of duty is in keeping with the finest traditions of military service and reflects great credit upon the unit, the 1st Brigade Combat Team, the 4th Infantry Division, and the United States Army.
