Authority: AR 600-8-22, paragraph 7-15


Reason: For exceptionally meritorious service. During the period 1 September 2009 to 26 June 2010, Detachment, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 38th Infantry Division and its subordinate units assigned to Task Force Cyclone displayed exceptionally meritorious service in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. Task Force Cyclone conducted full spectrum counterinsurgency operations in the Regional Command East provinces of Bamyan, Parwan, Panjshir and Kapisa along with development, security and governance while being responsible for base operations at Bagram Airfield. Task Force Cyclone provided more than \$5 billion worth of development in their area of responsibility and developed an unprecedented amount of governance capacity and capability which significantly improved the security and lives of the Afghan people. Task Force Cyclone was responsible for the formation of the Kabul Base Cluster Area Support Group to unify eleven camps and bases within the Kabul Capital Region with improved efficiencies in base operations. The dedication and outstanding performance of Task Force Cyclone are in keeping with the finest traditions of military service and reflect great credit upon the unit, Combined Joint Task Force-82, United States Forces-Afghanistan, United States Central Command and the United States Army.
