

Christopher Warren, M.A., J.D., serves as a Historian with Arlington National Cemetery (ANC), the U.S. Soldiers' and Airmen's National Cemetery, and the Department of the Army. Prior to joining ANC, Mr. Warren worked as a Historian for the US Department of Defense including the U.S. Air Force History Program and the Naval History & Heritage Command in Washington, DC. He also served as a Special Agent specializing in counterterrorism and counterintelligence with the Federal Bureau of Investigation in New York City, and as a US Air Force Intelligence Officer for 7 years. His research specialties include military history, 20th century United States and European history, early aviation, the history of chemical and biological weapons, and World War I. He has published articles in numerous publications including *MHQ: The Quarterly Journal of Military History*, *Federal History Journal*, *Naval Aviation News*, and routinely lectures on historic topics. Mr. Warren is currently pursuing his Ph.D. in the Department of History at George Mason University, and his doctoral dissertation focuses on the American experience in the First World War. He completed his master's degree in History in 2011 and his Juris Doctorate in Law in 2005 from George Mason University. In 1998, he graduated with his bachelor's degree in History from the University of Kansas.
