





**MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION**

**SUBJECT: Authorization of an Armed Forces Expeditionary Campaign Streamer for Operations in Somalia, 5 December 1992–31 March 1995**

1. I hereby authorize an Armed Forces Expeditionary Campaign Streamer for Operations RESTORE HOPE and UNITED SHIELD in Somalia for the period 5 December 1992 through 31 March 1995. These operations included a series of historically significant combat actions and involved the deployment of substantial Army forces in a combat posture for an extended period of time.
2. Army units that participated in Operations RESTORE HOPE and UNITED SHIELD during this period that are authorized an organizational color or distinguishing flag and otherwise have been determined to be qualified for campaign participation credit in accordance with current policies will be authorized to display a campaign streamer in the pattern of the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal Ribbon inscribed SOMALIA.
3. Department of the Army General Orders will be issued through the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army listing specific unit authorizations for the streamer, and the award will be added to the official lineage and honors of authorized units. Additionally, a streamer will be placed on the Army Flag with the inscription SOMALIA 1992–1995.
