
Announcement is made of the following award:

Period of service: 1 January 2006 to 15 April 2007
Authority: AR 600-8-22, paragraph 7-16
Reason: For outstanding meritorious service. During the period 1 January 2006 to 15 April 2007, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st Battalion, 13th Aviation Regiment and its subordinate units displayed outstanding meritorious service in support of United States Army Soldiers and the soldiers of forty-four allied and friendly nations participating in sixty-five aviation related courses at the United States Aviation Warfighting Center and Fort Rucker, Alabama. The unit trained, supported, and provided command and control for the 1,078 officers, noncommissioned officers, and Soldiers attending technical and graduate flight training to provide the Army with flexible and adaptive Soldiers and leaders. In addition, to executing the Aviation Life Support Equipment Course to provide the Army with trained technicians, the unit also assumed control of a course previously administered and taught by the United States Air Force, moved it, and established it at Fort Rucker to meet the Army's requirement for Pneudralics Repair Specialists. Additionally, the unit trained 1,081 Soldiers attending Initial Entry Training and Military Occupational Specialty Training as Air Traffic Controllers, Aviation Operations Specialists, and Helicopter Repairmen. During the same timeframe, the unit executed the Department of Defense Field Studies Program to ensure the 714 international military students trained at Fort Rucker gained a greater understanding of America and its culture, economy, government, legal system, and media. Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st Battalion, 13th Aviation Regiment's outstanding performance of duty is in keeping with the finest traditions of military service and reflects great credit upon the unit, the 1st Aviation Brigade, and the United States Army.
