Period of service: 1 November 2004 to 1 February 2006


Authority: AR 600-8-22, paragraph 7-16

Reason: During the period of 1 November 2004 to 1 February 2006, the 90th Regional Readiness Command (-) displayed outstanding meritorious service in support of hurricane relief efforts and Operations Enduring and Iraqi Freedom. The command trained, prepared, and equipped over 16,000 Soldiers and provided major equipment to mobilize, deploy, and re-deploy troops in support of the Global War on Terrorism. The unit also conducted relief and recovery missions in Louisiana and Texas in the aftermaths of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. The unit evacuated and secured affected military personnel and equipment, and provided shelter and relief for the civilian population. Further, the command played a key role in the Army's transformation by providing timely and accurate information and plans in support of both Base Realignment and Closure initiatives and the Army Reserve Command and Control restructuring. The unit also planned and served as the executive agent for Operation Desert Warrior 2005, a combined joint field training exercise involving over 4,500 active and reserve component forces from the U.S. Army, U.S. Air Force, U.S. Marine Corps, and the Canadian Army. The actions of the 90th Regional Readiness Command (-) are in keeping with the finest traditions of military service and reflect distinct credit upon the unit and the United States Army.
