

Reason: For extraordinary heroism in action against an armed enemy. During the period 10 March 2007 to 1 January 2008, Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 1st Battalion, 10th Field Artillery Regiment and its subordinate units displayed extraordinary heroism in action against an armed enemy in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. In addition to assisting in detainee operations at Camp Bucca in Southern Iraq, the unit also conducted over 233 combat patrols, 20 terrain denial fires, four counter-fire missions, and ten major operations in and around Narwan in Central Iraq. The unit's ability to provide exceptional command and control capability enabled decisive victory in these operations. The unit was also instrumental in forming 220 concerned citizen volunteer programs in its area of operations and in continuing to foster goodwill among the Iraqi people. Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 1st Battalion, 10th Field Artillery Regiment's outstanding performance of duty is in keeping with the finest traditions of military service and reflects great credit upon the unit, the 3d Infantry Division, and the United States Army.
