Reason: For outstanding meritorious service. During the period 1 July 2004 to 30 November 2006, Headquarters, 3d Brigade, 85th Division (Training Support) and its subordinate units displayed outstanding meritorious service in support of the Global War on Terrorism. The unit successfully trained over 28,000 Soldiers from 300 units without any major accidents or disruptions.
