Award: Meritorious Unit Commendation

Period of service: 18 June 2010 to 12 June 2011

Authority: AR 600-8-22, paragraph 7-15

Reason: For exceptionally meritorious service. During the period 18 June 2010 to 12 June 2011, the 274th Transportation Detachment displayed exceptionally meritorious service in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. The unit operated an entry control point, processed and tracked all cargo inbound and outbound from Forward Operating Base Shank, Afghanistan. The Soldiers of the unit processed more than 10,700 host nation trucks, CL-III tankers, gravel delivery, and Surface Deployment and Distribution Command strategic cargo trucks for delivery to or onward movement in support of customer units. The unit processed more than 36,000 passenger airlift requests, which averaged more than 50 air movement requests weekly in support of customers traveling into and out of the Logar and Wardak Provinces. The unit's team mission execution and commitment to excellence set a new standard for air and ground operations. The actions of the 274th Transportation Detachment are in keeping with the highest military traditions and reflect great credit upon the unit, the 313th Joint Movement Control Battalion, the Joint Sustainment Command-Afghanistan and the United States Army.
