Award: Meritorious Unit Commendation

Period of service: 11 November 2010 to 4 November 2011

Authority: AR 600-8-22, paragraph 7-15

Reason: For exceptionally meritorious service. During the period 11 November 2010 to 4 November 2011, the 200th Transportation Detachment displayed exceptionally meritorious service while serving in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. The unit operated the vehicle control point and the arrival and departure area control group, processed and tracked all pax and cargo inbound and outbound from Forward Operating Base Sharana, Afghanistan. The Soldiers of the unit processed more than 35,000 host nation trucks, Class I and Class III tankers, gravel, delivery and Surface Deployment and Distribution Command cargo trucks for delivery to or onward movement in support of customer units. The 200th Transportation Detachment processed more than 68,000 passenger airlift requests and 12,200 pallets carrying over 42 million pounds of cargo traveling into and out of Forward Operating Base Sharana. The unit's mission execution and commitment to excellence set a new standard for air and ground operations. The actions of the 200th Transportation Detachment are in keeping with the highest traditions of military service and reflect great credit upon its Soldiers, the unit, the 313th Joint Movement Control Battalion, the Joint Sustainment Command-Afghanistan and the United States Army.


