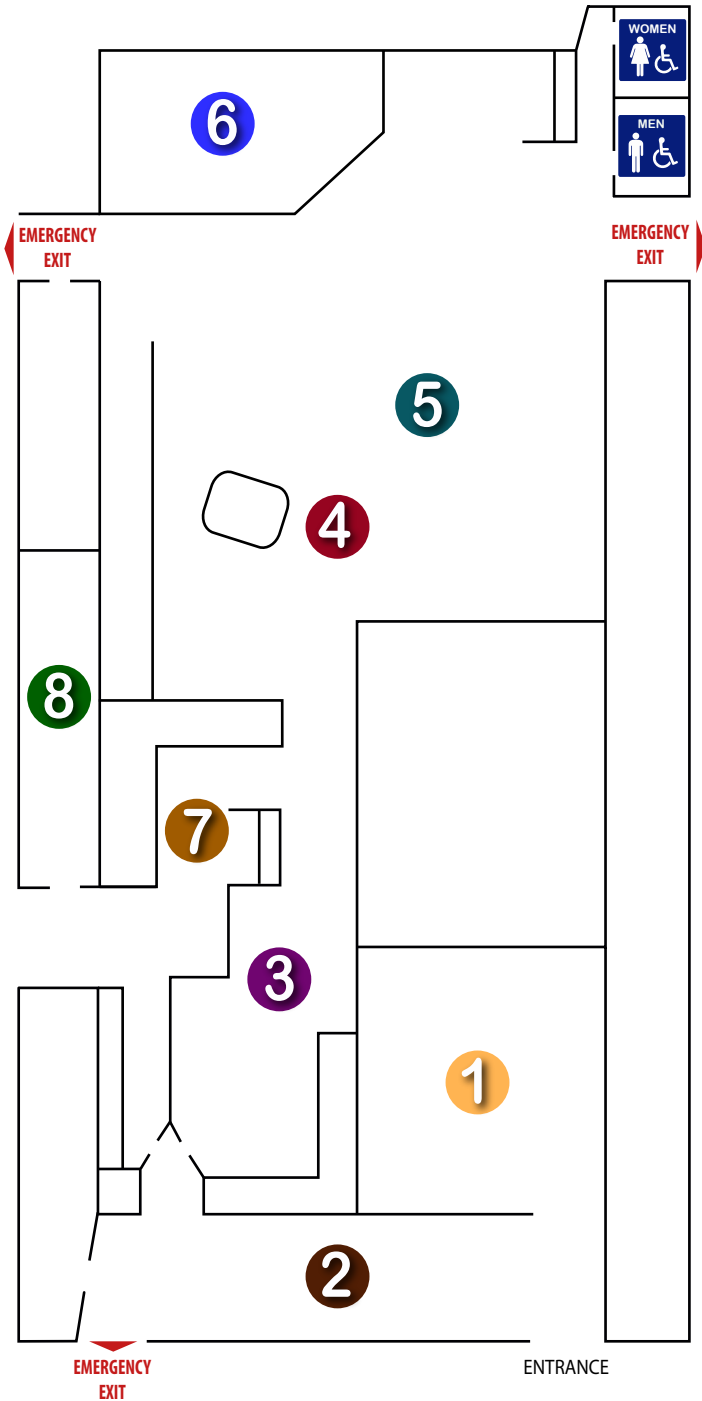

- 1 Fort Leavenworth Gallery** – Connect with the man that established Cantonment Leavenworth in 1827.
- 2 Front Hallway** – Discover the history of Fort Leavenworth, 1827 thru 1945.
- 3 Beyond Lewis & Clark** – Explore how the Corps of Discovery surveyed and mapped our American West in search of a passageway to the Pacific in 1804. Learn about the many other expeditions that followed and led to settlement of the West.
- 4 Campaign Gallery** – Investigate the many military campaigns, uniforms, equipment, arms and artillery of the Frontier Army.
- 5 Vehicle Exhibits** – Look at horse-drawn vehicles that helped establish the original museum in 1938.
- 6 Punitive Expedition** – “Eyes to the Sky”. This was the first military excursion to deploy biplanes. The “Jenny” was used by the Signal Corps as an observation aircraft.
- 7 Personality Vehicles** – View the carriage that Abraham Lincoln rode in when he visited Missouri and the Kansas Territory in 1859.
- 8 Special Exhibitions** – These exhibits cover various topics and are available for a limited time.
